THE 43rd ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE MEDALISTS

The Florence Nightingale Medal is awarded by the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) to up to 50 qualified nurses worldwide each year who are active members or regular helpers of a National Red Cross or Red Crescent Society or of an affiliated medical or nursing institution. Medal recipients were active in public health, conflict situations, disaster situations and nursing education. The 2011 Nurse Recipients of the 43rd Florence Nightingale Medal join 64 distinguished United States nursing leaders who have received the Medal since its first presentation in 1920 and are as follows:
